



# Tsushima City Guide for separation and disposal of garbage and recyclables

Please put general household garbage at the specified collection location by 8:30 am on the day of collection. Please use the bags specified by Tsushima City.

## Recyclables

<b>Plastic containers and wrapping materials</b> 	Styrofoam, plastic bottles, plastic bags, plastic cups, plastic netting, etc. 	Specified bags for plastic containers and wrapping materials Bag color: transparent blue	Once a week <input type="text"/>
<b>Empty bottles</b>	Drink bottles, cosmetic bottles (not translucent white bottles), beer mugs, other non-returnable bottles, etc. 	 Specified container	Once a month The <input type="text"/> <input type="text"/> of each month
<b>Empty cans</b>	Aluminum and steel cans Spray cans, cassette-type gas canisters, and cans used for food 	 Specified container	Once a month The <input type="text"/> <input type="text"/> of each month
<b>Plastic bottles</b> 	Plastic bottles for drinks, soy sauce, mirin, vinegar, and alcoholic drinks. 	Specified bags for plastic bottles Bag color: transparent	Twice a month The <input type="text"/> <input type="text"/>
<b>Paper and clothing</b>	Newspapers, flyers, magazines, cardboard boxes, paper, clothing, etc.  These should be sorted by item and cross-tied. Clothing should be placed in a bag (do not use a specified type of bag).	None.	Once a month The <input type="text"/> <input type="text"/> of each month
<b>Hazardous garbage</b>	Batteries, thermometers, fluorescent tubes, and lighters 	 Specified container	Twice a year (June and November) The <input type="text"/> <input type="text"/>

## Garbage

<b>Burnable garbage</b>	Plastic products (other than containers and wrapping materials), uneaten food, paper diapers, sanitary products, futons, blankets, carpets, etc. 	Specified bags for burnable garbage Bag color: translucent	Twice a week <input type="text"/> and <input type="text"/>
<b>Unburnable garbage</b>	Toys, rubber products, plastic jerry can, planters, metal products, etc.  Pottery and pieces of glass should be put into a sand bag and put out as oversized garbage.	Specified bags for unburnable garbage Bag color: transparent pink	Once a month The <input type="text"/> <input type="text"/> of each month
<b>Oversized garbage</b> (Paid for collection from individual households)	Desks, chairs, chest of drawers, bicycles, etc. * Please purchase an oversized garbage certificate stamp.  Please call the Oversized Garbage Reception Center to request collection. Reception hours: Monday to Friday (except for national holidays, year end, and New Years) 9 am to 5 pm (closed from 12 to 1 pm) Tel: 31-3284 The maximum number of items accepted is 5 per household each time.
