





Tsushima City Guide for separation and disposal of garbage and recyclables

• Please put general household garbage at the specified collection location by 8:30 am on the day of collection. Please use the bags specified by Tsushima City.

Recyclables

Type	Examples	Specified bags to be used	Collection frequency
Plastic containers and wrapping materials 	Styrofoam, plastic bottles, plastic bags, plastic cups, plastic netting, etc. 	Specified bags for plastic containers and wrapping materials Bag color: transparent blue 	Once a week <input type="text"/>
Empty bottles	Drink bottles, cosmetic bottles (not translucent white bottles), beer mugs, other non-returnable bottles, etc. 	Specified container 	Once a month The <input type="text"/> of each month
Empty cans	Aluminum and steel cans Spray cans, cassette-type gas canisters, and cans used for food 	Specified container 	Once a month The <input type="text"/> of each month
Plastic bottles  PET	Plastic bottles for drinks, soy sauce, mirin, vinegar, and alcoholic drinks. 	Specified bags for plastic bottles Bag color: transparent 	Twice a month The <input type="text"/>
Paper and clothing	Newspapers, flyers, magazines, cardboard boxes, paper, clothing, etc.  These should be sorted by item and cross-tied. Clothing should be placed in a bag (do not use a specified type of bag).	None.	Once a month The <input type="text"/> of each month
Hazardous garbage	Batteries, thermometers, fluorescent tubes, and lighters 	Specified container 	Twice a year (June and November) The <input type="text"/>

Garbage

Type	Examples	Specified bags to be used	Collection frequency
Burnable garbage	Plastic products (other than containers and wrapping materials), uneaten food, paper diapers, sanitary products, futons, blankets, carpets, etc. 	Specified bags for burnable garbage Bag color: translucent 	Twice a week <input type="text"/> and <input type="text"/>
Unburnable garbage	Toys, rubber products, plastic jerry can, planters, metal products, etc.  Pottery and pieces of glass should be put into a sand bag and put out as oversized garbage.	Specified bags for unburnable garbage Bag color: transparent pink 	Once a month The <input type="text"/> of each month
Oversized garbage (Paid for collection from individual households)	Desks, chairs, chest of drawers, bicycles, etc. * Please purchase an oversized garbage certificate stamp.  Please call the Oversized Garbage Reception Center to request collection. Reception hours: Monday to Friday (except for national holidays, year end, and New Years) 9 am to 5 pm (closed from 12 to 1 pm) Tel: 31-3284 The maximum number of items accepted is 5 per household each time.	None.	Once a week <input type="text"/>
